## Player Waiver

## Birth Certificates

Please provide a copy of your players birth certificate and report card to your coach. Coach will provide a U.S. Basketball Games folder which will include players birth certificates, report cards and player info to U.S. Basketball Games Directors.

## Accommodations

## Uniforms

## Trainers

Trainer will be on-site for all athletes to provide athlete training. Trainers will not tape players ankles, etc., but will check for injuries. No cost to parents!

## Playing Time

Playing time is not guaranteed! Coaches decision.

## Rules (abbreviated)

10U/11U: 14-minute halves (stop clock)

12U-14U: 15-minute halves (stop clock)

15U and above: 18-minute halves (stop clock)

2-minute half time

Overtime periods will be 2 minutes (each team will receive one full time out)

25-point mercy rule will be in effect. Clock will run continuously except during timeouts. Clock goes back to regular time once the trailing team point difference reaches 20 points.

11U, 12U, 13U and below plays with 28.5 basketballs

14U and above plays with 29.5 basketballs

Time Outs; 2 – Full and 2 - :30 second time outs per game

5 Fouls equal disqualification from the game

Coach can protest a game - \$100 bond (cash) must be given to Site Director

If coach, parent, friend or player is ejected from a game, they must leave premises immediately and cannot participate for duration of the tournament, and parents will not be refunded for admission or be allowed back onto venue property.

Actions will be reported to AAU, YBOA, USSSA, USA Basketball, US Amateur, NCAA and other youth sports governing organizations, subject to the coaches right to an appeal. Serious misconduct could result in additional discipline and local police.
